


## NUMBER OF CASHLESS TRANSACTIONS PER CAPITA/PER YEAR\*



## **DID YOU KNOW?**



94% of Lithuanian residents holding a payment account used internet banking in 2022, 69% used mobile payment apps (66% of them used apps to initiate payments and 36% to initiate contactless payments at POS terminals);




The average amount of cash (€ 110) in the wallet that Lithuanians carry at the beginning of the day is significantly bigger than in other Euro area countries (€ 83);



The share of SCT Inst transactions in the total number of euro credit transfers has been constantly growing and accounted for 64% in September 2022
