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## Profile – Members and Observers of the Card Fraud Prevention Forum

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### Card Fraud Prevention Forum Composition

The Card Fraud Prevention Forum (CFPF) is composed of a maximum of 30 participants:

- Members
  - The CFPF Chair.
  - PSP members (10 seats).
  - **Experts coming from card schemes (5 seats).**
  - **Experts coming from the Retail sector including e-merchants (5 seats).**
- Observers (maximum 10 seats)
  - **Experts from non-commercial organisations in a similar domain working in the card fraud prevention domain.**
  - Representation from European public authorities and organisations will be invited to participate in the CFPF (European Central Bank, European Banking Authority, European Commission and Europol).

Other organisations might also be invited as guests to participate in a meeting of the CFPF.

### Criteria for members and observers of the Card Fraud Prevention Forum

Suitable candidates for the member and Chair seats will be identified by the EPC following internal (EPC members) and external (stakeholders) calls for candidates. The mandate of CFPF members is two (2) years and is renewable. One **alternate** may be designated per member by the appointing institution to attend meetings in the absence of the corresponding member.

The experts coming from card schemes and the retail sector should be active in the card payments domain and have a thorough knowledge of card fraud prevention issues, both in their own institution and in the industry. Equally, observers are expected to be knowledgeable of card fraud prevention.

Members and observers will bear their own costs relating to CFPF meeting attendance.

To be considered, the candidate must clearly indicate in the application letter whether he or she seeks appointment to become a CFPF member as an expert coming from a card scheme or the retail sector, or to become an observer as an expert from a non-commercial organisation in a similar domain working in the card fraud prevention domain.
