Annex I: Use of the data element “Original Message Name Identification” in r-transactions, SCT inquiries and related response messages

R-transactions, SCT inquiries or response messages that are related to a message that was sent before the migration date in the 2009 message version of ISO 20022, need to refer to this 2009 message version in the element “Original Message Name Identification”, even though the SCT/SDD IGs currently indicate that in this element only the 2019 version of original message is allowed.

The maximum time span during which reference can be made to the 2009 message version will depend on the allowed period for sending the relevant type of r-transaction, SCT inquiry or response message as specified in each concerned rulebook. One needs to take into account that for example a Return (pacs.004) of an SCT transaction can be done within 3 Banking Business Days after settlement date, or a Refund (pacs.004) of an authorised SDD Core collection can be requested within 8 weeks of the debit date.
